Meeting Minutes for Tuesday December 2, 2025

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Tim Montondo at 7:00 PM immediately following the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Officers Reports:

- Minutes for the November 4th meeting were read and approved.
- Club Treasurer Jeff Kunzer gave his report for November. His report was approved. Jeff reported there were 546 paid members as of November 30, 2025.
- Jeff Kunzer also reported finding roofing nails on the range that were used to attach targets to the target frames instead of the much preferred, and safer, staples or tape. Nails and/or screws present a potential serious hazard to club mowing equipment and the possibility of such can puncture tires or present other hazards. Please do not use nails or screws to attach targets.

Old Business:

- At our October meeting, Walker Lee who sells insurance, spoke of an insurance policy that would suit the club well and the club did purchase. He has further suggested additional liability insurance for club officers and directors with an annual cost of around \$1500. VP Dave Samuelson will research the need and cost for same.
- The tenant who occupied the trailer on club property next to the range has died and the removal of his belongings is progressing. The club can then shut off electric and water and remove the trailer.
- The club's snowblower hasn't received any bids by any potential new owners. It is in good working order and is looking for a new home.
- Member Bill Haley's shooting components and press have been given to the club and are looking to be sold with the proceeds going to the Youth Fund. There is an abundance of 12 gauge wads and a very functional MEC Model 9000 loader for 20 gauge.
- The archery targets and backstops have been removed and moved into the barn until needed next year.
- Club Manager is still being sought.

New Business:

- The club will host the Hunter's Tour Shoot on Thursday, Saturday and Sunday January 22, 24 and 25, 2026. WCSC members will be needed all 3 days to insure all goes well with special attention to Thursday in operating traps, clearing snow, etc. Time volunteered goes toward member reduced annual dues.
- There are no spare clay target traps so it will be necessary to purchase at least two new ones. Jeff Kunzer will be doing that task and if anyone would like to learn the ropes of operating and maintaining the club's trap machines, Jeff could use the help.
- Election of club officers will take place at the February meeting. If you would like to be a candidate for an office or director, please make it known at the January meeting, or before by a written note to the attention of Tim Montondo.
