- Dying and dead ash trees on the Sporting Clay's course that could pose a risk to anyone on the path or the trap houses if they came down will have to be managed.

- The trial run of using solar charging panels for one of the new EZPull transmitter stations proved successful. One will be installed on a permanent basis when the weather gets warmer.
