Officers Reports:

- Minutes for the September 2nd meeting were read and approved.
- Club Treasurer Jeff Kunzer gave his report for September. His report was approved. Jeff reported there were 533 paid members as of September 30, 2025.
- Sporting Clay's Report: Jeff Kunzer reported there were more than 21,000 targets thrown during the month of September with about 235 shooters participating in the Hunter's Tour Shoot that WCSC hosted on September 24th, 26th and 27th. Also noted there was good participation in the Youth Program.

- A similar sealed bid sale will be offered to members interested in acquiring the club's snow blower. Interested bidders should visit the club when someone is there and have the barn open to inspect the snowblower. That would be most times when the Sporting Clay's and Skeet and Trap fields are open. - The club Swap Meet went fairly well and may become an annual event.
