Officers Reports:

- Minutes for the February 3rd meeting were read and approved.
- Club Treasurer Jeff Kunzer gave his report for February. His report was approved. Jeff reported there were 478 paid members as of February 28, 2026.

Old Business:

- The additional liability insurance for club officers and directors is still in process.
- The postponed Hunter's Tour Shoot will be held here at WCSC on Saturday and Sunday, March 28th and 29th. Score cards will be available for those that want to shoot on Thursday March 26th. New Business:

- Motion made and seconded to make our annual donation to SCOPE of \$1500. Motion carried. SCOPE meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of each month at the American Legion in Marion at 7:00 PM.
- Member Van Huston will be replacing the worn out tarps that cover the openings at each trap house.
- The club's Better Shot Shoot and fund raiser for the club's Youth Fund will be held this year on Saturday April 4th beginning at 9:00 AM. It will be called the "Shoot for Yoots". Charlie Schwegert and his able helpers will be offering all you can eat yellow perch and walleye fillets, coleslaw, chowder, beans and desserts. \$20.00 to shot a round of Sporting Clays for score. Members and non members encouraged to attend and shoot. Proceeds to benefit the club's Youth Fund.
- A shooting group, the RAAFA based in Rochester has requested use of the club's enclosed 25 yard shooting range and occasional use of the club house for their activities. Included will be NRA classes on shooting and gun safety. It sounds very positive and a 6 month trial basis will be offered.

- Thursday night, March 5th will be the last opportunity to shoot under the black lights until next fall. Being considered will be offering the 5 stand shoot using 6 traps on the skeet field on Thursday afternoons and Sunday mornings when the skeet fields are open to shooting. Same price: 25 targets for \$8.00.
- The archery targets will be setup in April for those members wanting a place to shoot. Field points only, no broadheads.
- The election of WCSC officers and directors was opened for any nominations from the floor. None were offered. Motion made and seconded to have the Secretary cast one vote for all existing Officers and Directors. Motion carried.
